- 2). Dissent – to disagree with (people dissented from the Anglican Church)
- 3). Divine right – authority given to monarchs by God (King James and King Charles)
- 4). Frontier – the unsettled area at the edge of the wilderness
- 5). Game – wild animals hunted for food
- 6). Heathens – unbelievers of Christianity
- 7). Persecute – to mistreat
- 8). Pioneers – people who venture (move) to the frontier
- 9). Reform – to improve/change
- 10). Refuge – a safe place
- 11). Representative – people selected to speak for others in matters of government
- 12). Representative government – government in which people choose those who make laws
and decisions (democracy)
