I. What kind of government did the Constitution establish?

Federal System: A system of government that divides power between the 50 state governments and the federal government

Federal = Central = National

Delegated Powers: Powers that are granted to the national government only	Reserved Powers: Powers that are granted to the state governments only	Concurrent Powers: Powers that federal and state governments share
