

## Causes and Effects of the French and Indian War

(French and most Native Americans vs. England, English colonies and some Native Americans)

Causes of the conflict between the French and English colonies	Effects of the War	British Response
English colonists ran out of land, they want to move West.	War costs a lot of money. The country must pay for soldiers, supplies, weapons, etc.	The British make new taxes that the colonists have to pay in order to pay off the war debt.
French and English both claim the Ohio River Valley	Britain gains control of the Ohio Valley and other land the French claimed.	British soldiers move into French forts in the West.
Native Americans and French are upset that the English colonists moved onto their land (Remember: the French developed the best relationship with Natives out of all European colonists).	The new "British" land in the West is full of unhappy Native Americans who just lost a war and some of their land.	After Pontiac's War, Britain passed the Proclamation of 1763: illegal for colonists to move further west.
