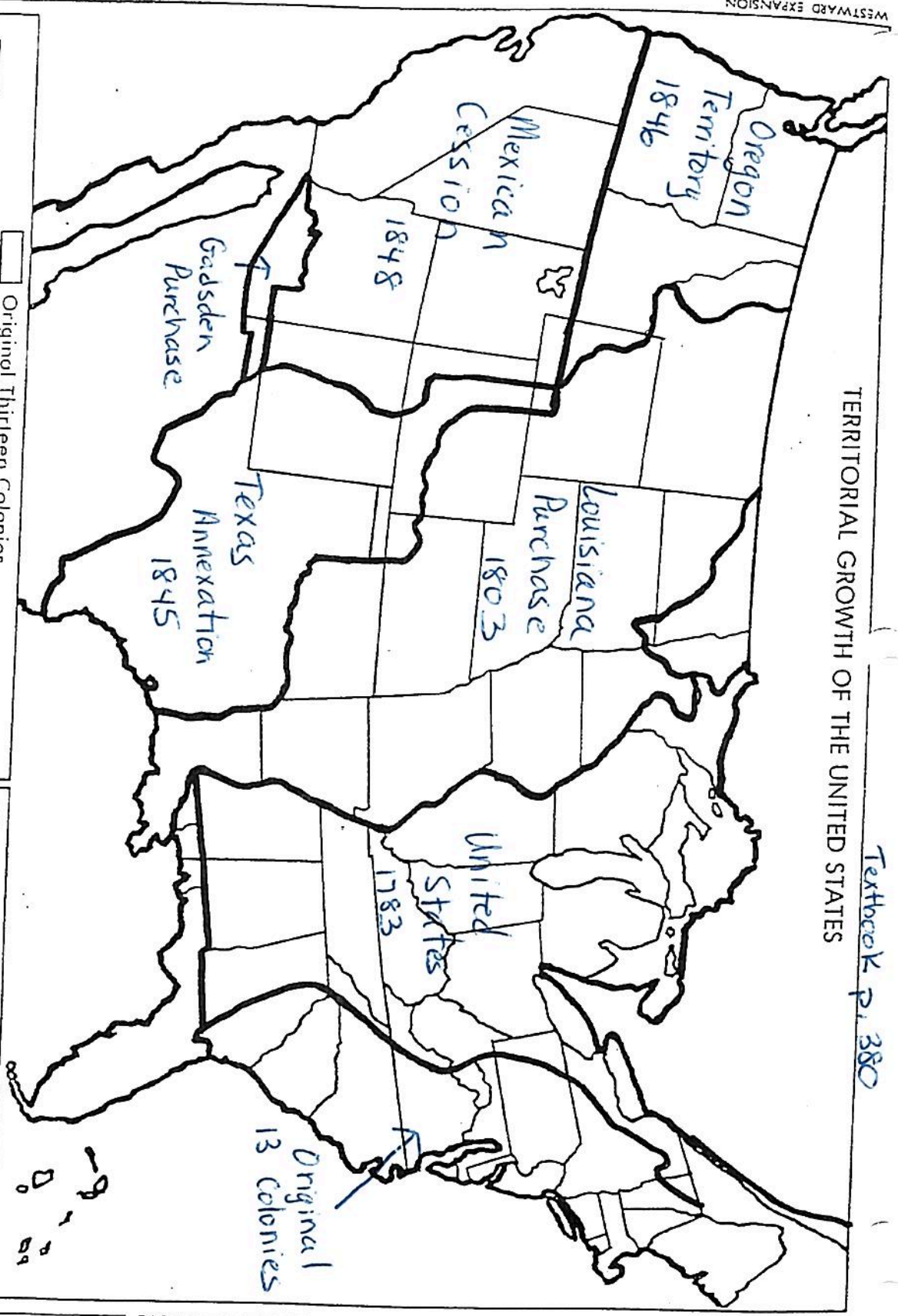

MANIFEST DESTINY

1). MANIFEST DESTINY IS THE BELIEF THAT AMERICA WAS DESTINED TO SPREAD OVER THE ENTIRE NORTH AMERICAN CONTINENT.

2). **THE FIVE REASONS WHY MANY AMERICANS SUPPORTED MANIFEST DESTINY:**

- AMERICANS WERE LAND HUNGRY
- PATRIOTS FEARED THE BRITISH COMING THERE
- EASTERN MERCHANTS NEEDED PORTS IN THE PACIFIC
- SPREAD DEMOCRACY
- EXPANSION WEST WOULD LEAD TO AMERICAN GREATNESS

3). **HOW DID THE US ACQUIRE THIS LAND?**

- LOUISIANA TERRITORY (1783) – PURCHASED WITH A TREATY FROM FRANCE
- FLORIDA (1819) – ADAMS-ONIS TREATY WITH SPAIN
- TEXAS (1845) – ANNEXATION BY THE US GOVERNMENT IN 1845
- MEXICAN CESSION (1848) – TREATY OF GUADALUPE HIDALGO (MEXICAN WAR)
- GADSDEN PURCHASE (1853) – TREATY WITH MEXICO
- OREGON COUNTRY (1846) – TREATY WITH GREAT BRITAIN

Events in Texas:

- 1). Texas was a province of Mexico.
- 2). Texas rebelled against the Republic of Mexico and General Santa Anna.
- 3). After its revolution, Texas was called the Lone Star Republic.
- 4). The first president of Texas was Sam Houston.
- 5). Annexation means "to add onto".
- 6). The 4 reasons why northerners opposed the annexation of Texas are:
 - A). The extension of slave territory
 - B). Increased Southern membership in the House of Representatives
 - C). Increased Southern membership in the Senate
 - D). Possibility of war with Mexico
