4th Quarter 2020
Grading Policy

- 1) Beginning Monday, May 4th, PowerSchool will calculate a numerical running average. This average is comprised of the Google Classroom Check-In scores, Castle Learning points and a Participation Grade (every student begins Quarter 4 with 100 points and loses 5 points for each missed assignment). Any missed assignments will lose participation points and result in a score of 0. **Previous assignment scores will NOT be included in this calculation.**

Example:

	Student X	Maximum Points
5/4 Google Check-In	5	7
5/6 Castle Learning	80	100
5/11 Google Check-In	3	5
5/13 Castle Learning	90	100
5/18 Google Check-In	4	4
Q4 Participation	100	100
TOTAL	282	316

Student X Average:

282 points earned
316 possible points

≈ 89%

- 2) The Google Classroom Check-In for Wednesday, May 20th, will include a question asking you to choose whether you prefer a **numeric grade** or **Pass/Fail** for the fourth quarter. **Please do NOT email us prior to this date.**

Please note: If you are choosing Pass/Fail for the quarter, numeric grades will still appear on PowerSchool until final grades are posted (PASS will replace grades 65 and above, FAIL will replace grades 64 and below).

- 3) Your PreAlgebra average for the entire year will be:
- If you choose P/F, the average of Q1, Q2, and Q3.
 - If you choose a numeric grade, the average of Q1, Q2, Q3, and Q4.
